



## Developing Active Global Learners Project

### Embedding the Global Dimension at Liverpool Hope University

**Andrea Bullivant** has recently joined LWC as the Global Dimension Support Officer, working closely with Liverpool Hope University (LHU) on their Developing Active Global Learners Project. This will allow LWC to continue building on their role in promoting global education across Merseyside through an approach which co-ordinates the work of schools, higher education institutions such as Hope and other organisations working in this area (NGO's, LEA's and community groups). Andrea comes from a background of teaching in higher education and delivering awareness raising around refugee issues and looks forward to drawing on this experience to develop her role with LWC.

Since April 2007 LHU has embarked on a project to develop active global learners and embed the global dimension at the University in partnership with LWC and Manchester Development Education Project. LWC has worked closely with LHU tutors to promote understanding of the global dimension within their Initial Teacher Education programme. As the project moves into its next phase LWC continue to work with LHU to share practice and learning from the project with schools and organisations linked to education. A conference to showcase best practice is planned to take place in June 2009.
