We now have around 62 schools which have been involved, and are all at different stages in terms of the levels at which Fair Trade is integrated into school ethos and activities.

Becoming a Fairtrade School shows that you are committed to Fairtrade, you sell and use Fairtrade products as far as you can and you raise awareness of Fairtrade in the school and local community.

To start becoming a Fairtrade School is simple, just register on the 'Fairtrade Foundation we are a Fairtrade School' (<http://www.fairtrade.org.uk/schools/>) website to start the process.

As well as registering on the Fairtrade Foundation website, Liverpool World Centre has made it possible for you to communicate with other Fairtrade Schools, who can offer you guidance and support throughout the process.

Area 7 - Hope Valley CP School

"At Hope Valley Fair Trade is an intrinsic part of the PSHCE scheme which all teachers deliver using a variety of resources bought with our Fair Trade grant. Resources are suitable for all year groups from Nursery to Year 6 and enable staff to incorporate Fair Trade into all areas of the curriculum.

Children in both key stages enjoy learning more through regular Fair Trade assemblies delivered by the PSHCE co-ordinator and her Y6 class. Fair Trade is also referred to in other individual class assemblies on a wider theme.

When promoting Fair Trade we always try to keep the message simple e.g. encourage children to ask their parents/carers to try just one Fair Trade product a week. This can often lead to discussions in class about favourite items.

Fair Trade is an enjoyable and important part of the curriculum at Hope Valley".
